Please note the following revisions and clarifications to the above referenced project:

**Question:** The RFQ does not specifically mention geotechnical work. Is that something that the main design firms will include on their teams, or will it be handled by the county differently?

**Answer:** The prime consultants will be responsible for having the appropriate geotechnical expertise on their design teams.

**Question:** RFQ 14-002-38 requests relevant experience (case studies) for public and private sector projects (two from each sector). I would like to verify the need for the private sector experience (case studies) for these particular RFQs.

**Answer:** Please submit a minimum of four (4) public sector projects as opposed to two (2) public sector projects and two (2) private sector projects as originally stated in the RFQ.

**Question:** Does any of the intersection improvements require traffic signal design?

**Answer:** Types of intersection improvements needed will be decisions that will be made through the design process.

**Question:** Is geotechnical investigation to be included in this project?

**Answer:** See prior response.
