1. Does the County expect that in-person data collection will comprise a certain percentage of the scope? Knowing an estimated range, such as less than 25%, 25%-50% or 50%-75% would be helpful.

We are assuming that the majority of the data can be collected remotely, but in the case that aerial or street-level imagery is insufficient or unavailable, field work would need to be conducted to collect or QC the data. Based on similar data collection efforts, our guess would be less than 25% of the data would need to be collected in the field.

2. Does the County already have a sense of the level of detail the inventory data should achieve? For instance, simply the presence or absence and length of sidewalks, curb ramps, overpasses, off-street connectors, parks, recreational walkways, and hiking trails? Or more detailed attributes, such as the width, pavement material and quality, slope, and cross-slope of these facilities?

In addition to the presence and length of the facilities, we are looking for attributes on the width of pathways and general type of ramps/crosswalks/etc. We are not expecting to collect detailed information on the condition or slope of the facilities.
