The above described sealed bid has been modified as follows to include a Special Provision – Stormwater Control:

STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1.1 The CONTRACTOR shall minimize environmental pollution and damage that may occur as the result of construction activities. The environmental resources within the project boundaries and those affected outside the limits of permanent work shall be protected during the entire duration of this contract. The CONTRACTOR shall plan for and provide environmental protective measures required to correct conditions that develop during the construction associated with this project. The CONTRACTOR shall comply with all applicable environmental Federal, State and local laws and regulations. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for any delays resulting from failure to comply with environmental laws and regulations.
- 1.2 The CONTRACTOR shall ensure compliance with this section by subcontractors.

- 1.3 All permits required by the U.S. Corps of Engineers, State of Tennessee Department of Water Resources, local government MS4 programs, and any other applicable laws and regulations shall be obtained prior to beginning any construction activities covered by said permits.
- 1.4 The CONTRACTOR shall submit within thirty (30) days, in writing, an original and two copies, of all Construction Permit Notice of Intents (NOIs), Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit (ARAP) applications, Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plans (SWPPPs), erosion control plans, photographs, wetland determinations, descriptions, drawings and any other documentation necessary to obtain all applicable stormwater permits to the County Engineer for review.
- 1.5 Upon approval of the submittals, the contractor shall, at their expense submit said documentation and required fees to the appropriate authorities to obtain coverage. The CONTRACTOR shall respond, modify or supplement any documentation as required by the permitting authority in order to obtain coverage. Documentation of coverage or coverage is not required shall be delivered to the County Engineer for retention.
- 1.6 The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible of complying with all environmental permit provisions and commitments required by Federal, State, and local environmental laws and regulations and, under the terms and conditions of the permit, install, inspect, maintain BMPs, prepare stormwater erosion and sediment control inspection reports, and submit SWPPP inspection reports. Maintain construction operations and management in compliance with the terms and conditions of the general permit for stormwater discharges from construction activities.

Also, the public bid opening date has been changed to February 18, 2016 @ 2:30 p.m.

All other requirements of this bid remain unchanged.
